WHO IS TCAT-PULASKI?

The Tennessee College of Applied Technology Pulaski serves students in Giles County and surrounding areas in southern Middle Tennessee. Along with the main campus in Pulaski, programs are offered at Lawrence County High School, Summertown High School, Loretto High School, and the Instructional Service Center at the former Murray Ohio building in Lawrenceburg.

WHAT IS DUAL ENROLLMENT?

The term "Dual Enrollment" refers to students being enrolled in two educational institutions at the same time. Students would be enrolled in high school and get college credit from TCAT-Pulaski at the same time. Dual Enrollment is free of charge to students, provided they are eligible for the dual enrollment grant.

WHAT DO WE DO NEXT?

Check out the dual enrollment offerings at your school by talking to your child's guidance counselor or call TCAT Pulaski at 931-424-2400. Make sure your child has a dual enrollment class set in his or her schedule before school starts by speaking to the school counselor about your child's schedule. A representative from TCAT will visit each school and get those students individually enrolled.

HOW IS IT FREE?

Any student in 11th or 12th grade that is a Tennessee Resident (has lived in Tennessee for a least one calendar year) can apply for a grant from the Tennessee Student Assistance Corporation online. This is the same portal with the same log-in credentials as the Tennessee Promise Scholarship, so be sure to keep your log-in information somewhere safe. As long as your child maintains a TCAT-Pulaski GPA of 2.75 or above, they can keep receiving the grant money to offset the cost.

WHEN & WHERE WILL MY CHILD ATTEND DUAL ENROLLMENT CLASSES?

Your child will attend their dual enrollment classes based on which high school they attend and their individual class schedule. Some students come to the TCAT-Pulaski Campus for classes, while others attend at their high school campus. Talk with your school counselor with further questions or call us at 931-424-2400.

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER GRADUATION?

The credit successfully earned while taking advantage of dual enrollment transfers over entirely when the student graduates high school, enrolling now as an "adult student" from "dual enrollment" status. Call our admissions department at 931-424-2428 to get that "adult" application taken care of, and learn about further admissions steps.
